Strengthening Families Protective Factors



Concrete support in times of need

Access to concrete support and services that address a family's needs and help minimize stress



Knowledge of Successful Parenting Strategies and Childhood Development

Understanding child development and parenting strategies help align age appropriate expectations that support physical, cognitive, language, social and emotional development.



Social Connections

Assist in reducing isolation and developing positive relationships to lean on in times of stress.



Parental Resilience

Managing stress and functioning well when faced with challenges, adversity and trauma.




Social and Emotional Competence of Children

Family and child interactions that help children develop the ability to communicate clearly, recognize and regulate their emotions, and establish and maintain healthy relationships.




