

I have to imagine many of us have questions about the start of the new school year. The University of Washington, through the Center on Reinventing Public Education has been tracking the responses to COVID 19 from school districts across the United States. It appears each district has its own rules and regulations and level of district has its own rules and regulations and level of implementation from minimum to extensive. School districts in all three counties, Thurston, Lewis, and Mason appear to be offering in-person, remote, and a blend of the two to accommodate student learning and safety. The best chance of having a voice in the experience of your children's new school year is to contact your school district office or school principle to learn the specifics of how your child's school is responding to COVID. When you find new information do share this with other Kinship caregivers at the Kinship Support Group meetings or through general conversation. 

EMERGENCY BROADBAND BENEFIT

DURING THE PANDEMIC

What is it?

A temporary FCC program to help households struggling to afford internet service during the pandemic.

The benefit provides:



Who is eligible?

A household is eligible if one member of the household:

- Has an income that is at or below 135% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines or participates in certain government assistance programs; Receives benefits under the free and reduced-price school lunch or
- Receives benefits under the free and reduced-price school lanch of breakfast program;
 Received a Federal Pell Grant during the current award year;
 Experienced a substantial loss of income due to job loss or furlough since February 29, 2020; or
 Meets the eligibility criteria for a participating provider's existing low-income or COVID-19 program.
