- The Fatherhood position is responsible for effectively provision of training, and support to men influencing child well-being in accordance with agency mission and in accordance with program fidelity, procedures and learning objectives. In addition, this position will promote positive fatherhood strategies across our service communities in an effort to build parental resilience.
- Must have strong communication skills and be a leader in building relationships with staff, community partners, and the community
- Bachelor's degree in education or a relevant field; equivalent formal professional training for this programming
- Relevant experience in a training or development instructor role, preferably in a related industry
- Proven ability to conduct training and development programs for participants that achieve learning objectives
- Proven ability to assist with the creation of training materials and content
- Proven skills to maintain a disciplined, orderly, and productive learning environment
- Proven skills to supervise training testing integrity, reporting and documentation, including attendance, results, and participant feedback
- Proven ability to use participant feedback to improve the training programming and curriculum

- Effectively teaches content according to the chosen curriculum and learning objectives for the class or individual participants
- Instructs participants using a variety of learning methods to meet different learning styles and student needs
- Skilled in interacting with and engaging all types of students, cultural backgrounds and learning styles
- Creates and modifies training materials and content that address all learning objectives and are highly rated by participants
- Ensures all training materials are updated for the latest changes in procedures and regulations
- Proactively explores new ideas, teaching methods and best practices from leading organizations and experts in the field
- Maintains a disciplined, orderly, and productive classroom environment
- Encourages student participation, discussion, and positive interactions between students
- Efficiently manages training logistics, including scheduling, invitations, access, room reservations and materials
- Manages testing procedures to evaluate student progress, including monitoring the test environment to ensure testing integrity
- Maintains up-to-date participant and class documentation; promptly addresses any requirements that are past due or incomplete
- Tracks class rosters, attendance, completion percentages, scores, and participant feedback for all training classes
- Oversee evidence-based service provision with fidelity to contract expectations
- Studies issues identified during training delivery and participant feedback to improve training instruction and curriculum
